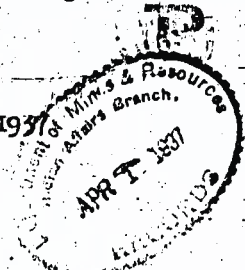

Dear Sir:

This is your authority to engage Dr. George Shannon, Jr., of Sault Ste. Marie, to do the dental work required at the Shingwauk Indian Residential School at the usual rate of \$30.00 a day including expenses. This authorization is for not more than two days' work.

The Department is in receipt of a letter from the Reverend Mr. Hives in which he states that he sent a child to the dentist suffering from a tooth-ache. The dentist later told him that he had not been paid for this work. We would like to know the circumstances of this if you can give us any information.

Mr. Hives also asks about having the children's eyes tested for spectacles when it is deemed necessary. A recent circular states that such authorization must be obtained from Ottawa. If the Principal will write to the Department regarding individual cases, he will be instructed what to do regarding them.

I wish to refer to your letter file 13-0-13 dated 12th. March 1946, with regard to dental work for the Shingwauk Indian Residential School.

Dr. Goodfellow of Sault Ste. Marie, spent an evening examining the mouths of all children in this school, and finds that the following work is required:

- 80 Extractions.
- 230 Fillings.

Like all dentists at this time, Dr. Goodfellow is very busy, but thinks he can get a good portion of the work done during the next three months. Time required will be at least ten days.

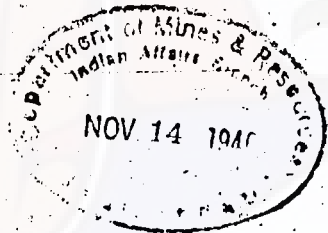
