

I instructed the Chapleau Agency on the 29th ultime and beg to submit the following report,-

I visited the Chapleau Indian Residential School and found everything very satisfactory. The buildings and equipment are in excellent condition. The interior of the school is kept tidy, sanitary and spotlessly clean. The pupils remaining in residence during holidays looked real well, healthy and happs. Six pupils passed entrance this term. Dr. Sheahan reports the health of the school very good.

The new fire escapes are a great improvement. Fire drill is regularly carried out. Some of the smaller pupils get frightened descending the steps. The backs of the steps are open and look dangerous to them. I would recommend that Agent Godfrey be authorized to purchase sufficient wire netting to cover the back part of the steps. The cost would be very small and it would add to the protection of the pupils.

The barn has not yet been completed to provide a key mow and the management is handicapped in having to buy hay in small quantities. I re-ported upon this last year, but lack of funds prevented the work being done. If funds are available it should be done this fall.
