There has been more sickness among the Indians during the month than usual, mostly measles, colds and a few cases of pneumonia. Two Indians died during the month, one with advanced T.B. in the Fort William Sanatorium and the other a pupil of the Fort Frances Residential School with blood-poisoning (Cryptogenic sepsis)

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
